Even projects that have solid, well-defined project plans encounter some degree of change and waste. Shifting market conditions, budget cuts, staff restructuring, or any number of influences will disrupt the best plan. Scrum is the agile development process that allows teams to deliver usable software periodically throughout the life of the project, absorbing change and new requirements as the project proceeds.

Beginning with the history of agile development and moving through the disciplines promoted by Scrum, participants will gain a comprehensive understanding of the Scrum methodology while specifically reviewing the behaviors expected of a ScrumMaster.

Participants will complete the training with the knowledge to:

- Remove the barriers between development and the customer so the customer directly drives development
- Teach the customer how to maximize ROI and meet their objectives through Scrum
- Enhance the lives of the development team by facilitating creativity and empowerment
- Improve the productivity of the development team in any way possible
- Improve the engineering practices and tools so each increment of functionality is potentially shippable

After successfully completing this class, students will be registered with the Scrum Alliance as Certified Scrum Masters, and will have on-line access to the class training materials and any updates for one year. Participants can also claim 14 PDU's with the PMI.
